**Ripon High School Student Threat** 

Ripon, WI - On Wednesday, December 4, a Ripon High School student found a message

in one of the restrooms at Ripon High School threatening seventeen Ripon High School students.

Because the individual who created the list was unknown, Ripon High School and Ripon Middle

School went into soft lockdown and police were contacted. In a soft lockdown, students remain in

their classrooms and instruction continues. The named students were escorted from classrooms

by police and school officials to a secure room.

Once the named students were safe, the soft lockdown was lifted. Then, with school

officials, each student individually contacted their parents. Students were either picked up by their

parents or if given permission by their parents, escorted by police to their vehicle. Two of the

students were off-campus so police and school personnel traveled to each off-campus site to

ensure the safety of those students while their parents were contacted.

School will be in session on Thursday, December 5 for all students in the Ripon Area

School District. Ripon Area School District will continue to work with City of Ripon Police

Department to ensure the safety of the students district-wide. Anyone with information regarding

this situation is encouraged to contact the City of Ripon Police Department or Ripon High School

officials. The district will continue to communicate with parents via IC Messenger as information

becomes available.
