Dear RASD Families,

Governor Tony Evers extended the Safer at Home Order today. The state of Wisconsin issued the following [bulletin](#):

“Gov. Tony Evers today directed Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) Secretary-designee Andrea Palm to extend the Safer at Home order from April 24, 2020 to 8 a.m. Tuesday, May 26, 2020, or until a superseding order is issued.”

The bulletin notes that “public and private K-12 schools will remain closed for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year.”

The bulletin also reminds the public to *“continue to follow simple steps to avoid exposure to the virus and prevent illness including:*

- *Avoiding social gatherings with people of all ages (including playdates and sleepovers, parties, large family dinners, visitors in your home, non-essential workers in your house);*
- *Frequent and thorough hand washing with soap and water;*
- *Covering coughs and sneezes;*
- *Avoiding touching one's face; and*
- *Staying home.”*
