Bullying Report

The School Board accepted the review and update of the Annual Summary Report of Bullying for the 2015-2016 School Year. Based on a detailed data pull and reported incident review in Infinite Campus, the report was adjusted to read: BP/J with 1 (same), MP/Q with 3 (same), RMS/C with 5 (up from 0), RHS/L with 4 (up from 0) incidents of bullying. The administration, in an effort to increase awareness and accuracy of reporting, will meet regularly with Student Services Director Julie Krachow and school counselors to review incidents of bullying. In addition, a committee will be formed consisting of parents recommended by each school, school counselors and principals to look for ways to improve reporting, look for trends in student behavior, and recommend programs or training for staff, students, and parent trainings and develop the bullying report for 2016-17.

Salary and Stipend Guide – HR Work

The following positions have been added to the Salary and Stipend Guide: Auditorium Manager, 4PS Coordinator, LVEC Program Coordinator, Web Master, Summer Pool Supervisor, Winter Pool Director, and Summer Pool Director. These are not new positions, but rather positions that have historically not been listed in the Appendix.

Charter School Enrollment Task Force

The Charter School Enrollment Task Force met for the second time on September 21. Close to 40 people attended the meeting with many returning from the initial meeting last spring. The meeting focused on understanding our current state and reviewing the original charter school purpose as it relates to the mission and vision of the district. The task force will meet again on October 19.

International Happenings

The board welcomed the eight foreign exchange students this year in the district: Daniel Garcia Clemente from Venezuela; Patricia Suveti from Romania; Nina Nawrot from Germany; Ina Muegge from Germany; Victoire Perrin from France; Andrea Ferrada-Ojeda from Switzerland; Julia Marin de Oliveira from Brazil; Ramanya Thongkamnerd from Thailand. The high school music department is planning a trip to China in April 2017 and the German Department is planning a trip to Germany in June 2017.
