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Ripon Board of Education Purchases Two Additional Properties to Improve Combined Facility Site

Ripon, WI – Construction is complete on the combined middle and high school building for the Ripon

Area School District with the exception of a few final projects including demolition and site work at the

old middle school location. The Ripon Board of Education continues to take additional steps to improve

the grounds around the combined facility. Beginning in the spring of 2015, five houses on E. Sullivan

have been purchased and demolished to improve the site for the combined 6-12 school project.

Recently, the Board purchased two additional houses.

The newest properties are located at 710 St. Wenceslaus and 443 E. Sullivan. The Board finalized the

purchase of the properties for \$70,000 and \$130,000 respectively. According to Superintendent Whitrock,

"The house on Wenceslaus will be razed in late spring to add more parking to the old middle school lot.

The property will increase the overall parking by 32 stalls to total 121 stalls vs. the original design of 89

stalls. The house on E. Sullivan will be razed in mid August and the ground leveled out to increase the

green space around the 6-12 facility." The space will provide a safe outdoor playground area for middle

school students to occupy over lunch recess and serve as an additional practice field. The soccer field to

the south of the school was eliminated to accommodate the new south parking lot.
