Experience: 1-2 years experience working with families with mental health needs is a

plus, but not required. Specific licensure is not required.

Reports to: Director of Student Services

Job Goals: The overarching goal of this grant is to develop a comprehensive system

of partnerships, processes, and programs that support student mental

health.

## Essential Job Functions/Responsibilities:

1. Formulate a schedule and designated resources for implementing Social Emotional Learning curricula.

- 2. Develop a partnership with community mental health entities that establishes processes and protocols for inter-agency communication, referrals, and treatment of district students
- Schedule district-wide training for staff on newly available mental health resources, and regular updates on district/community mental health partnerships available to students and their families
- 4. Document trainings and maintain rosters of attendees. Survey staff regarding their attitudes toward the trainings and information provided.
- Develop a means to provide parents with information about access to district and community mental health resources, as well as information and activities to help their children build resilience
- 6. Build a bank of regularly updated online mental health resources, and make them available to staff, students, family members, community stakeholders, and community mental health partners
- Notify all school based mental health providers of the requirement to collect the number
  of students who have received contacts with School Based Mental Health Providers, and
  will create a temporary process and forms for such reporting.
- 8. Notify all school district personnel of the temporary process for referring students for mental health services to school based mental health providers or community mental health providers, and the need to advise the Mental Health Navigator of such referrals
- 9. Contact all community mental health providers to inform them of the district's responsibility and desire to accurately report such contacts by and with district students.

- 10. Formalize a system to collect data on the number of students who have received mental health services contact with School Based Mental Health providers and Community Mental Health providers
- 11. Attend the Community Coalition on Youth Mental Health monthly meetings and participate in working with these partners to develop a referral process that provides ready access to students and families to a range of mental health services and providers.
- 12. Communicate a warm, caring and respectful atmosphere to visitors, staff and community members that focus on quality customer service.
- 13. Remain free of any alcohol or illegal substance in the workplace throughout employment in the District.
- 14. Perform other duties as assigned.
- 15. Serves as a positive role model for students in how to conduct themselves as citizens and as responsible, intelligent human beings.
- 16. Will remain free of any alcohol or illegal substance in the workplace in compliance with Policy 3122 throughout his/her employment in the District.
