- Approval of Enrollment Cap at Odyssey
 - 4K-2→ 40 students per teacher
 - \circ 3-6 \rightarrow 40 students per teacher
 - \circ 7-12 \rightarrow 35 students per teacher

Background:

In January 2020, the School Board voted not to put open enrollment caps in place for open enrollment across the district, allowing the school district to accept open enrollment students through both the regular and alternative open enrollment windows. This year, the District has seen a significant increase in request from families seeking a virtual option for their children. The Odyssey Governance Council met to consider the enrollment caps as noted in the table below. With caps for Odyssey, the District would still be able to accept students through the alternative open enrollment window, though staff would direct students to the openings in the brick and mortar schools. A waitlist would be created for Odyssey so should a student leave that program, the next student on the waitlist would be offered a spot if needed to maintain the ideal student:teacher ratio throughout the school year as noted below. Although enrollment in grades 4K-2 is already over the ideal ratio, no current students would lose their seat.
