 - a) Showed we were trying to reach some of our economically disadvantaged kids, which is part of our grant
 - 4. Day in the Life was good

 - 6. Radio interview not sure (free, so good :)
 - 7. Charter chats not well-attended, but good people who did come
 - 8. Power of Play events were good
 - 9. Need to give information sooner and/or have childcare available

- c. Nature Playground
 - 1. School board did elect to go with the middle option for the playground, which is awesome
 - 2. School board wanted a hill to be the center of the playground
 - 3. School board was concerned about the waterpump and the boulders
 - 4. School board approved the \$65,000 option
 - a) Tanya was able to pull some building money to contribute to it this year and will likely be able to next year
 - b) Anticipated to be done before school year opens in the fall; likely by July
 - 5. Musical instruments that can be unbolted coming from grant

 - c. Tanya surveyed staff regarding teaching preferences
 - d. Any new hires will be interviewed by board members and teachers from each school because each new hire is expected to be versatile
 - e. Want to empower parents to make decisions for their kids; help them feel qualified to be able to choose
