- 2.1. Jill Pulmann-Becker & Chrissy Damm - Title 1 program presentation - ESSA (Every Student Succeeds Act) replaces No Child Left Behind. Quest has not qualified as Title 1 before, but this year for the first time Quest qualified. Title I - improving the academic achievement of economically disadvantaged youth. The school can pursue either targeted assistance programs or a schoolwide program. The model of Murray Park's schoolwide program was discussed and reviewed. The document will be shared with council members and teachers for input. Application is due by the end of April.
