


In 2024-25 the average homeowner with \$100,000 in equalized property value will pay \$693 in taxes to support school district operations, the lowest in over 40 years.

Revenue Sources


Over the past eleven years, state aid has provided roughly 60 percent of the District's revenue while local revenue has decreased from roughly 30 percent to 20 percent.

Student Enrollment



In the 2024-25 school year, total student enrollment increased by 44 students, reaching 1,705. This growth was primarily in four-year old kindergarten and at Odyssey Academy.

Operating Expenses



In the 2023-24 school year, operating expenditures totaled \$25,534,458. As with other school districts, 74% of this spending was allocated to staff salaries, wages and benefits.
