3. Request to move section of Kindergarten to Journey from Barlow Park (18 kids on the waitlist)

Carrie mentioned that if sections are added to Journey, the Governance Council needs to make sure that teachers who are transferring to Journey are supportive of Journey/project based learning and are not transferring just to keep their job.

b. Journey Waitlist for 2016-17
