Across the two years, students will cover concepts in each subject area: <i>Behavioral Sciences, Economics, Geography, Political Science, and History.</i></p>

Topics covered include: <i>Engineering Design, Physical Science, Life Science, and Earth's Place in the Universe.</i></p>

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<b>Physical Education</b>	Students will develop a physical fitness log of activity.
