The Catalyst Governance Council is taking applications for **two** council positions beginning with the 2017-18 school year. The positions will be for three years.

The Catalyst Governance Council has the authority for independent oversight of the charter school, its vision, goals, and educational program, including budgets, personnel, curriculum, charter school policies, and the overall operation of the charter school. Council membership qualifications include being a parent of a child in Catalyst or a community member who lives in Ripon and has an interest in Catalyst Charter Middle School.

The council meets once a month and as needed for individual sub-committees.

The position will be voted on by the parents/guardians (one vote per household) of any child currently attending Catalyst Charter Middle School. Voting will take place at the Showcase on May 4. Results will be announced and new members will attend their first meeting in June.
