



Kindergarten Immunization Requirements

Immunization is a shared responsibility

Parents are required to have their children immunized on schedule and keep accurate records. If a student is unable to receive immunizations for medical, religious or personal conviction reasons, a waiver must be signed. These waivers are available at each school, and are also printable from this website : https://www.ripn.k12.wi.us/district/health_services.cfm

The following vaccines are required for Kindergarten entry:

Kindergarten: 4 DTP/DTaP/DT/Td1, 4 Polio, 2 MMR, 2 Varicella, 3 Hep B

Schools are required to keep records of all student vaccinations, and review annually the Immunization Law (s. 252.04 Wis. Stats.).

When students do not meet the requirements of the law, parents are notified by a **legal notice**.

Helpful Hints:

- Keep a copy of your child's immunization record.
- Notify your child's school each time your child receives an immunization.
