Survey Description

The Ripon Area School District's Parent Satisfaction Survey is composed of 21 questions, each scored on a scale of 1-5, within four areas related to overall satisfaction. Since 2017, when the first survey was conducted, both participation and overall satisfaction have increased significantly.

Overall High Satisfaction Areas

- > Cleanliness and maintenance of the schools
- Safety of learning environment
- Student's access to supplies and equipment necessary for learning
- Family's respectful treatment
- > Recommendation of school to other parents
- Child's learning is high priority
