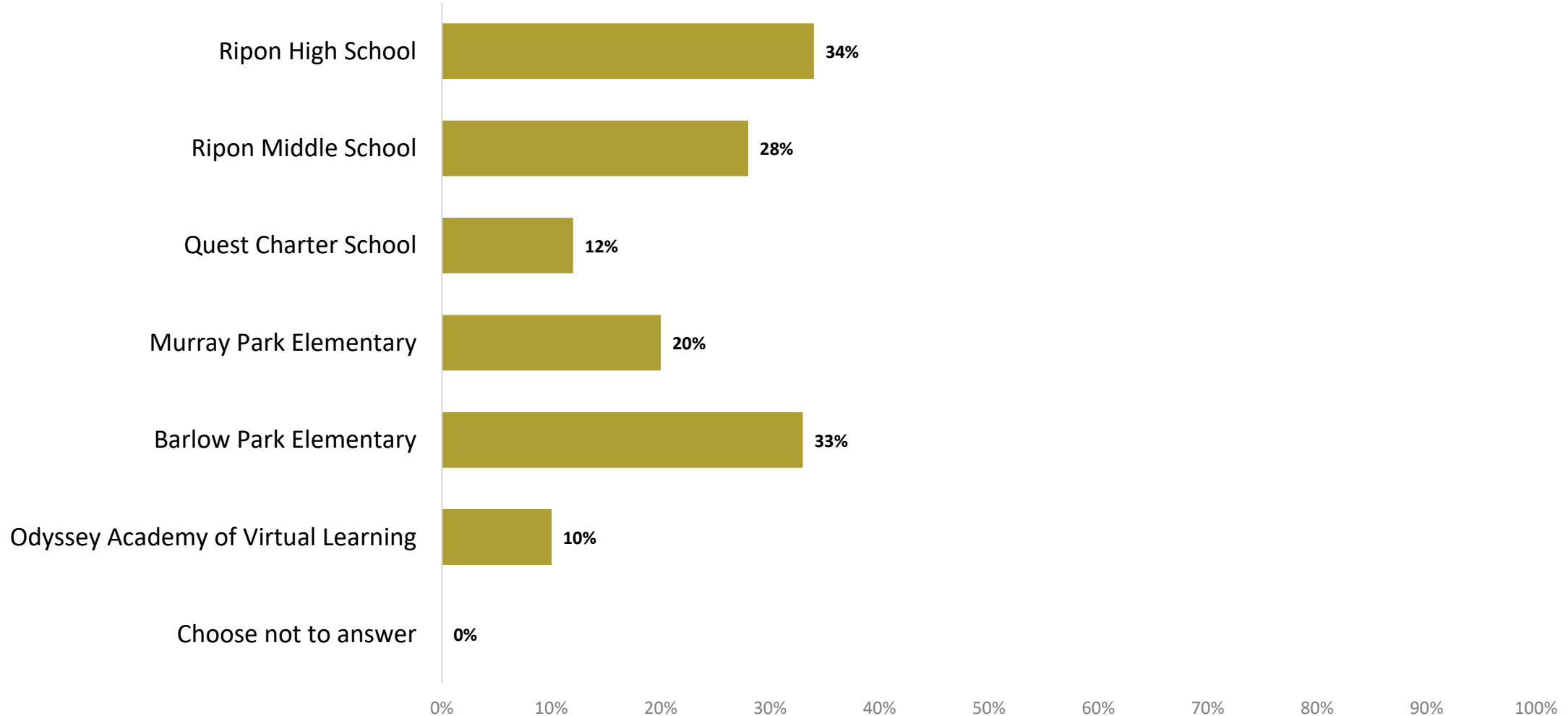

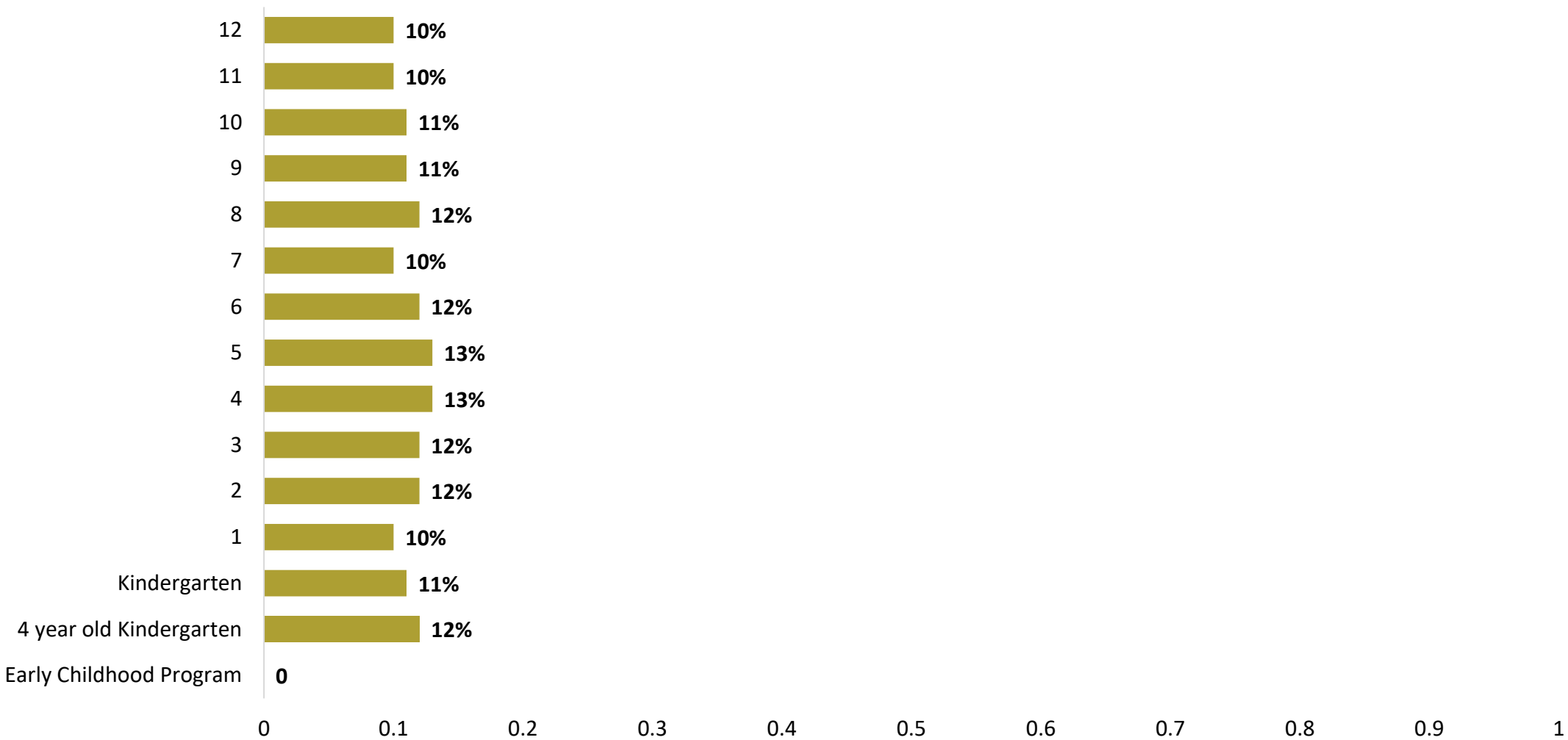
Which schools do your children attend?

(Select all that apply.)

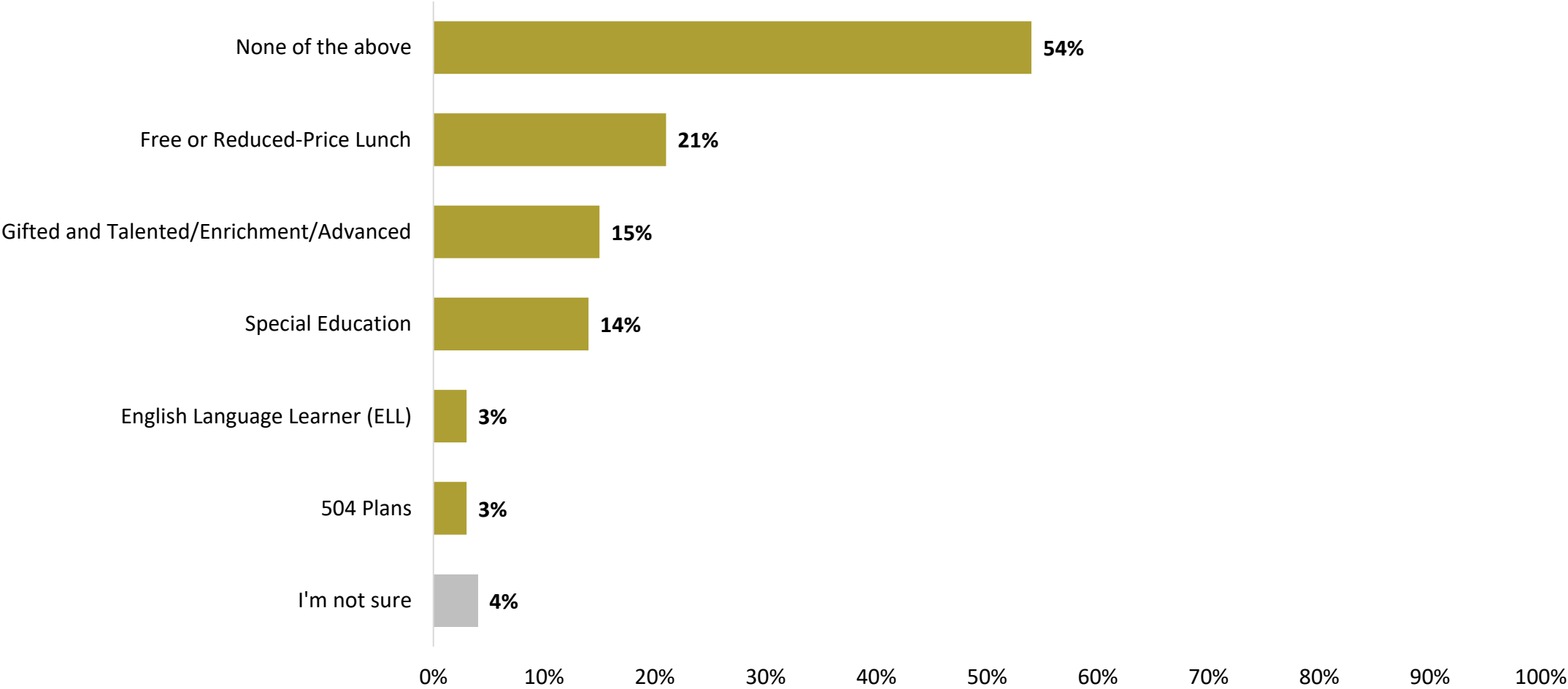


Grade level of your child(ren):

(Select all that apply.)

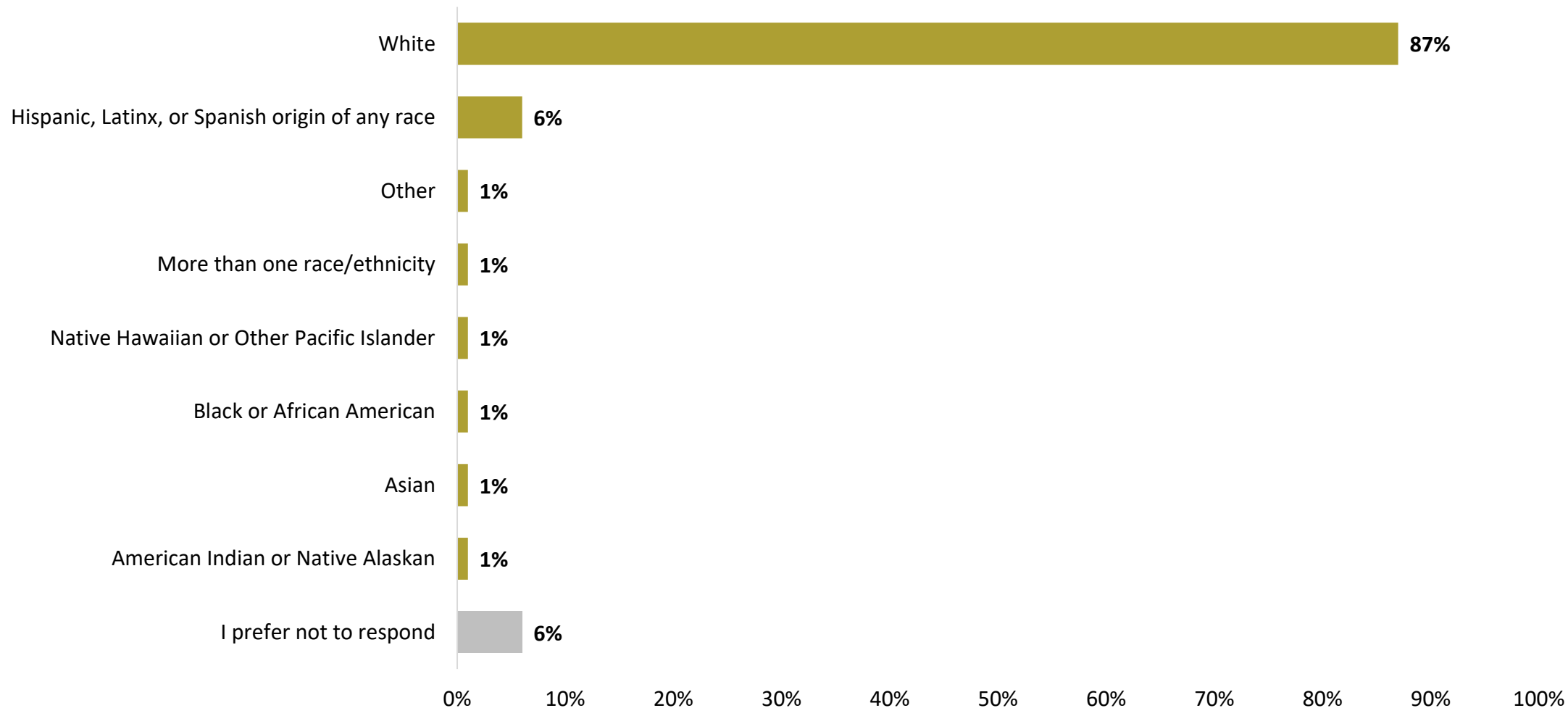

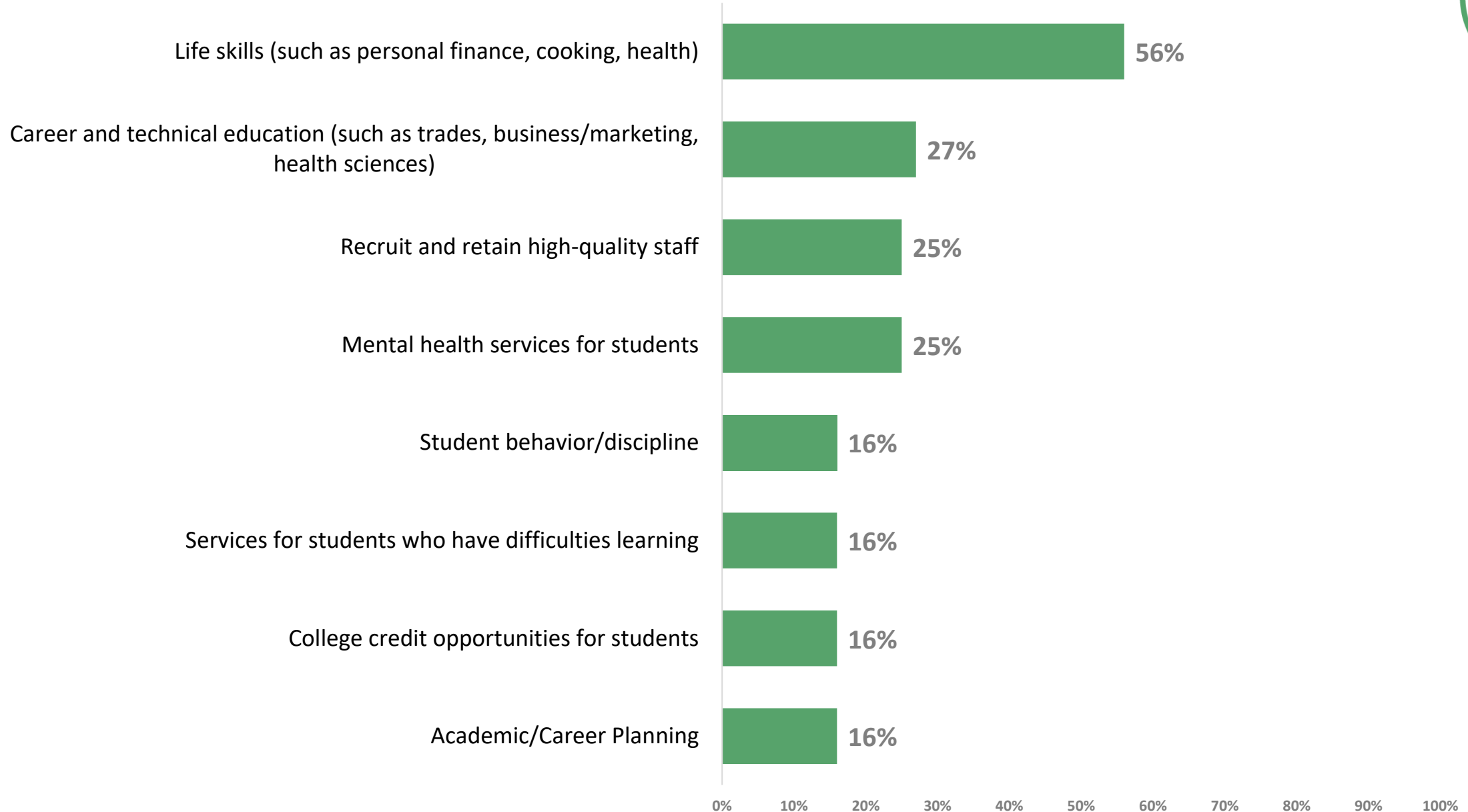

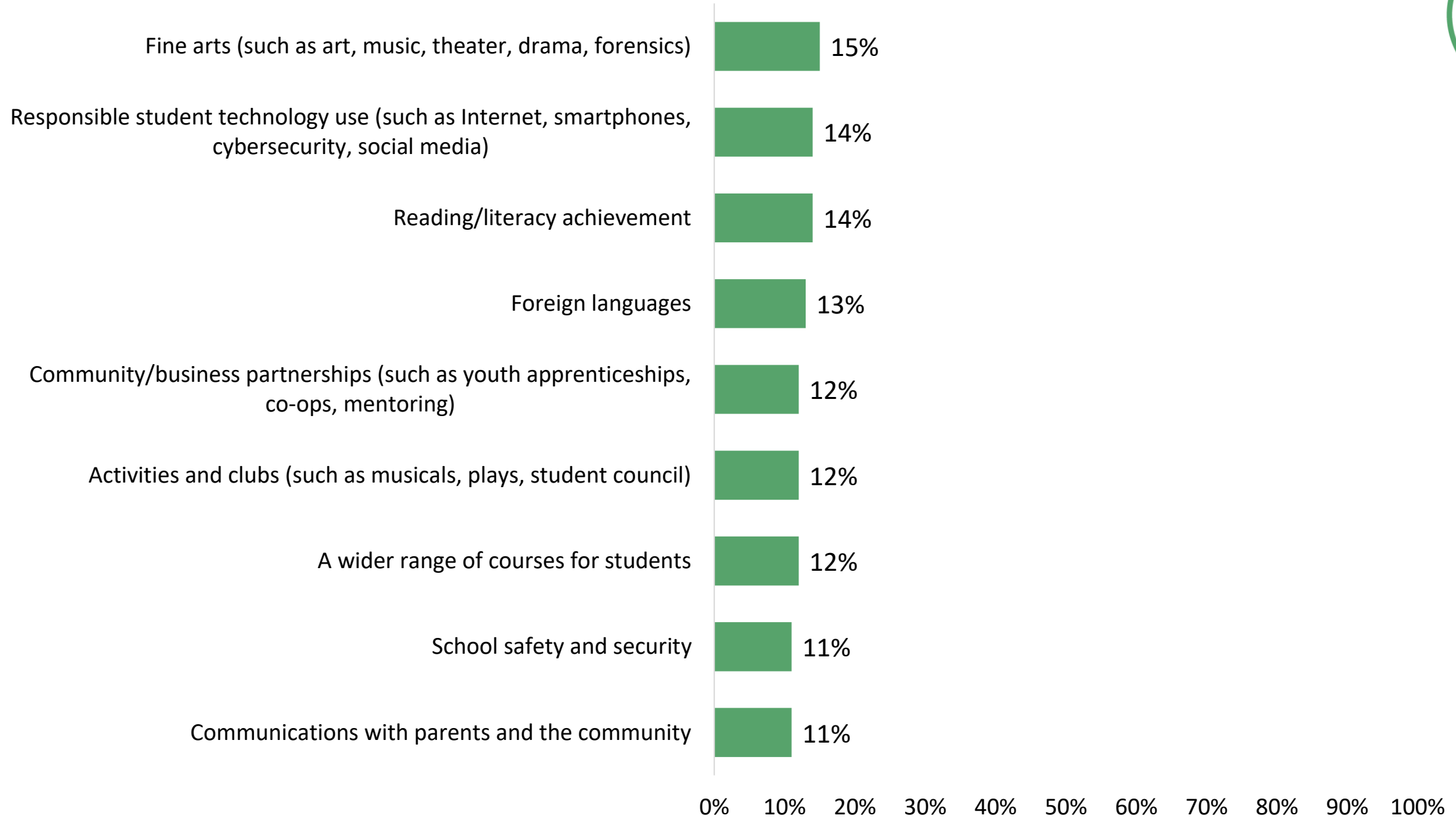


Areas to focus planning efforts. Respondents selected up to 4.

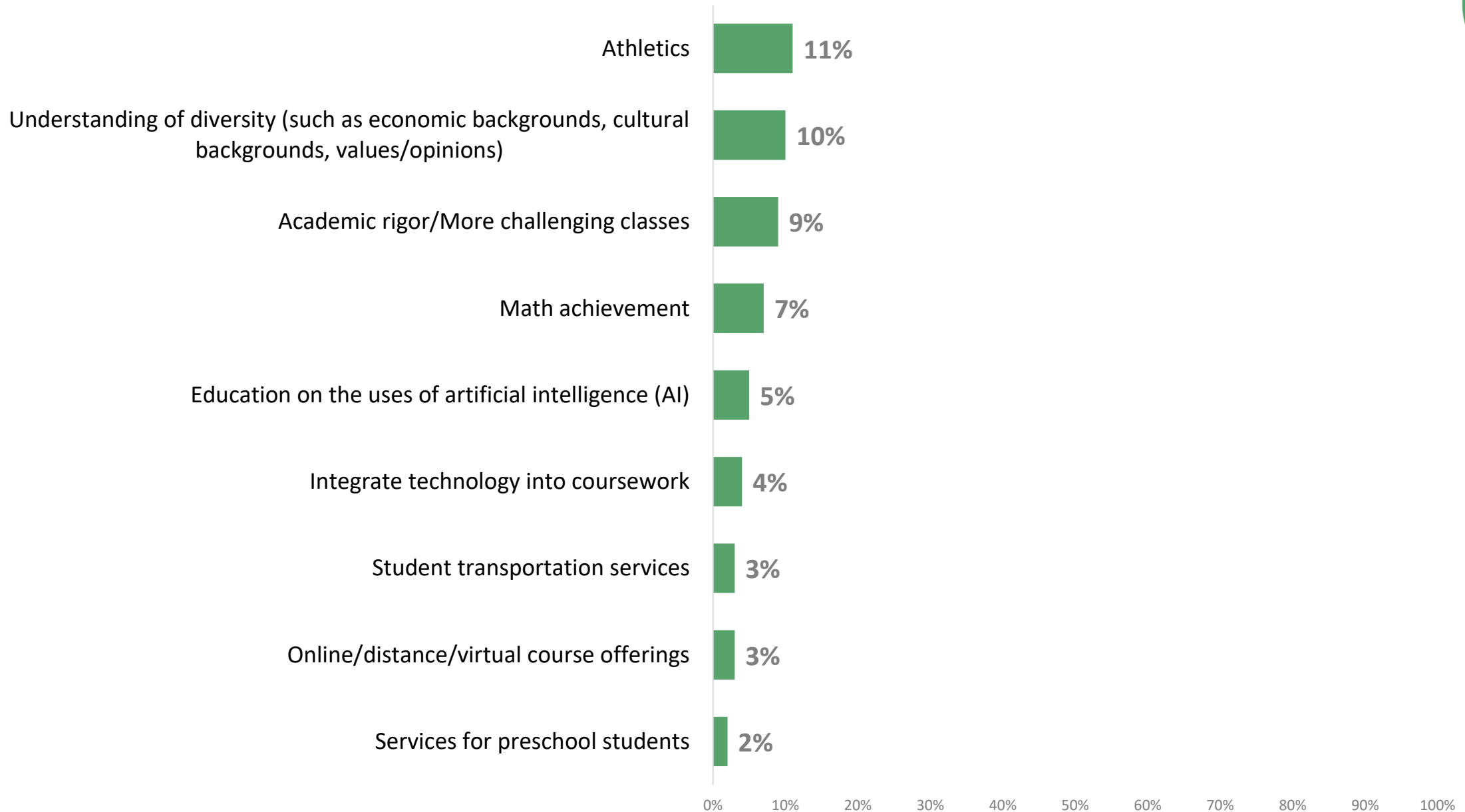

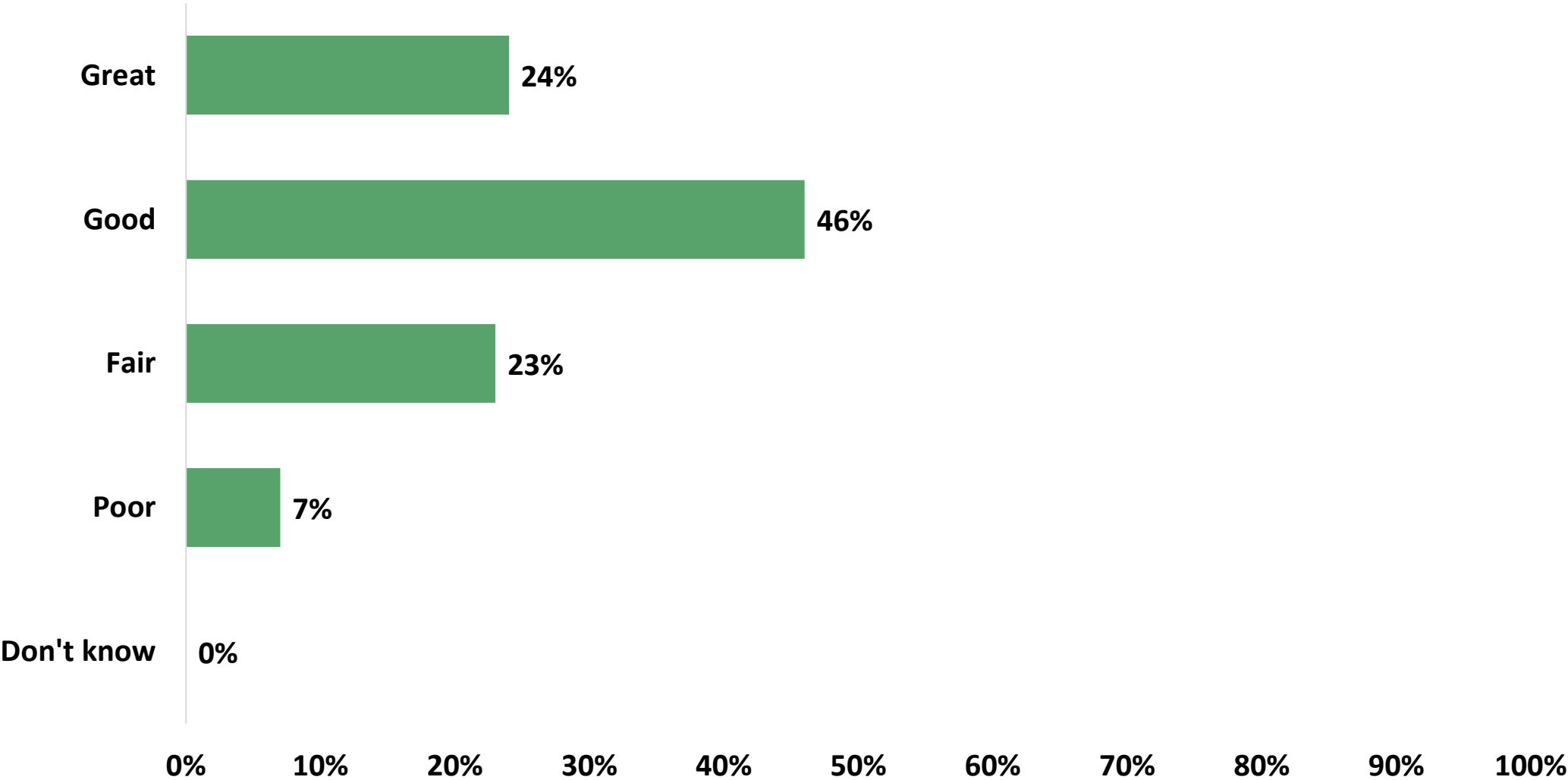

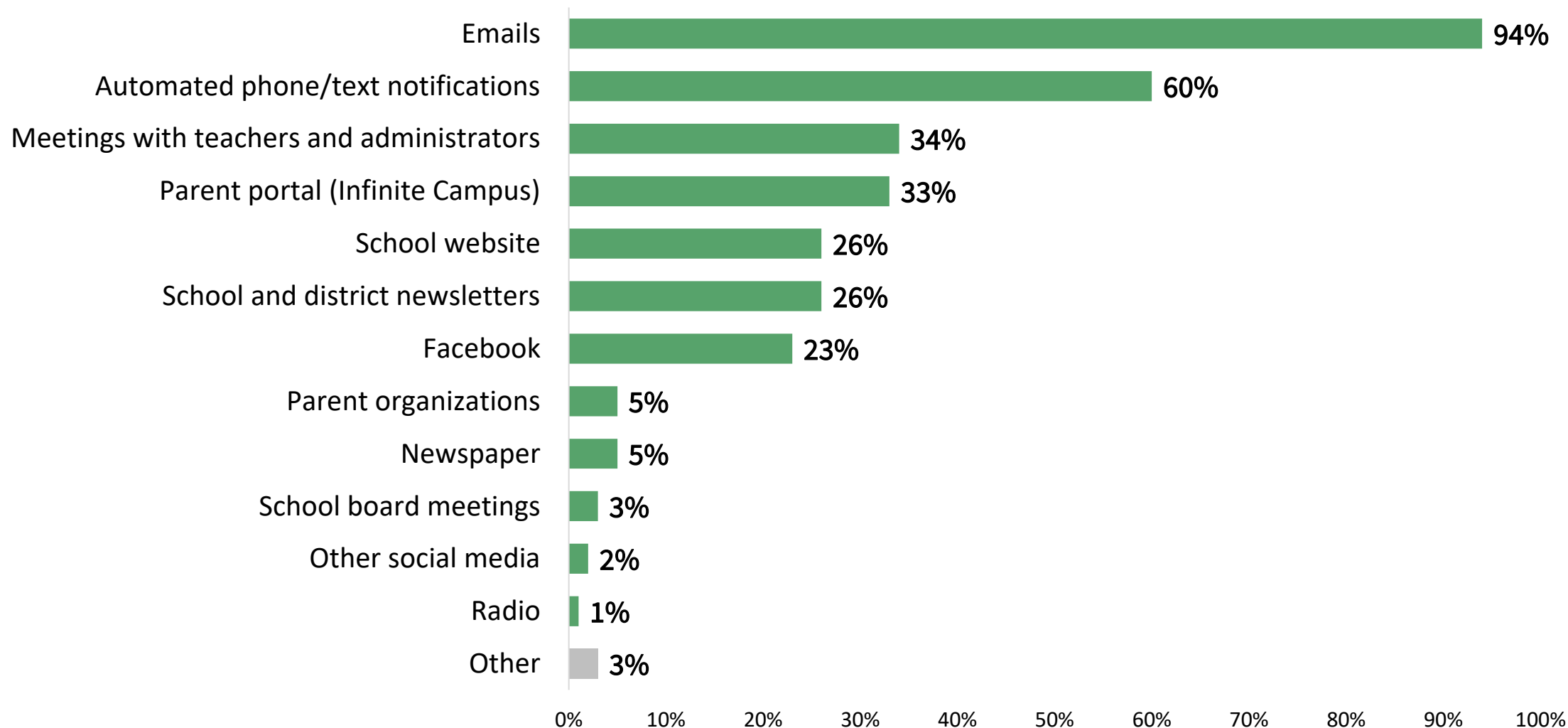


Overall, how would you rate communications from school?

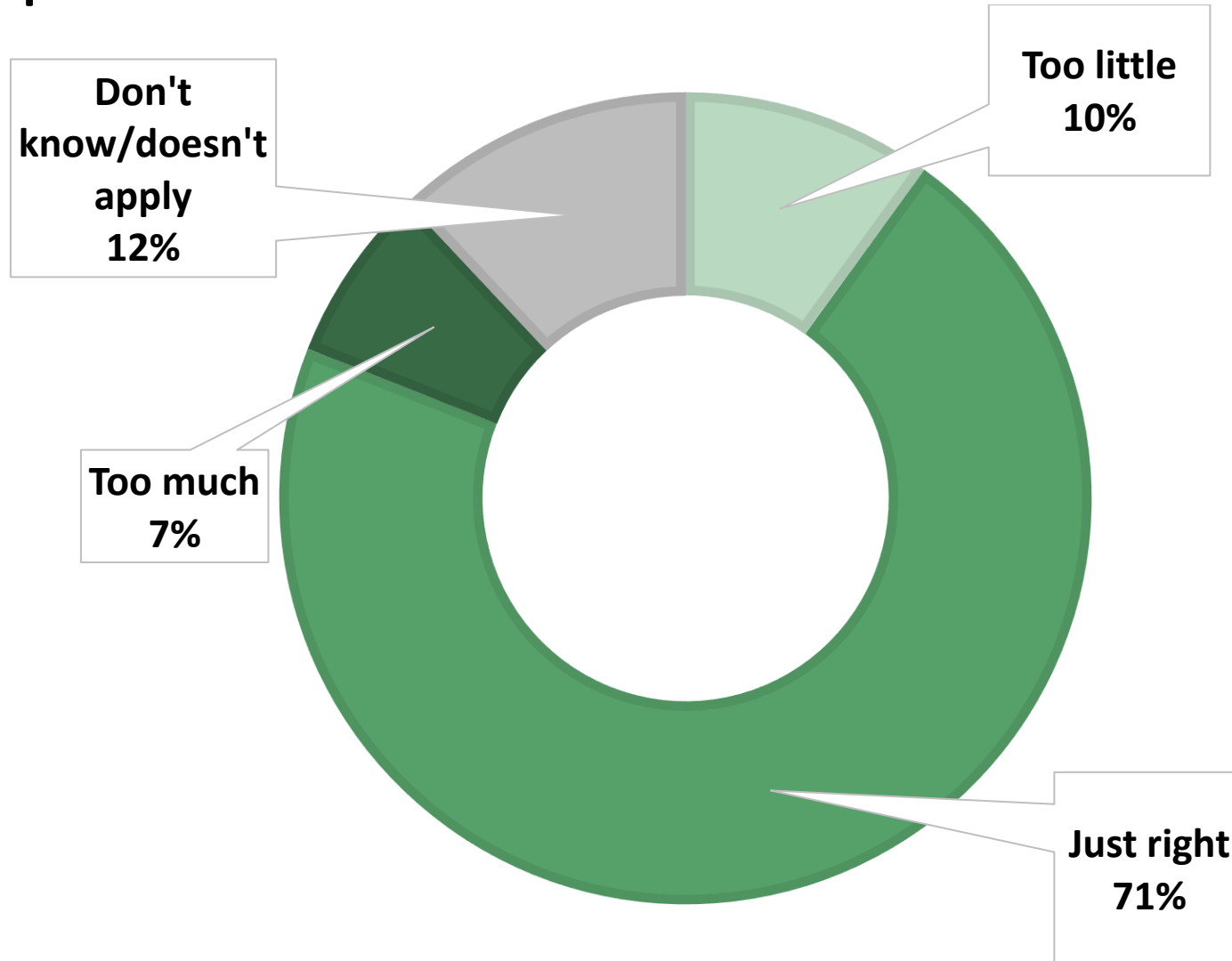

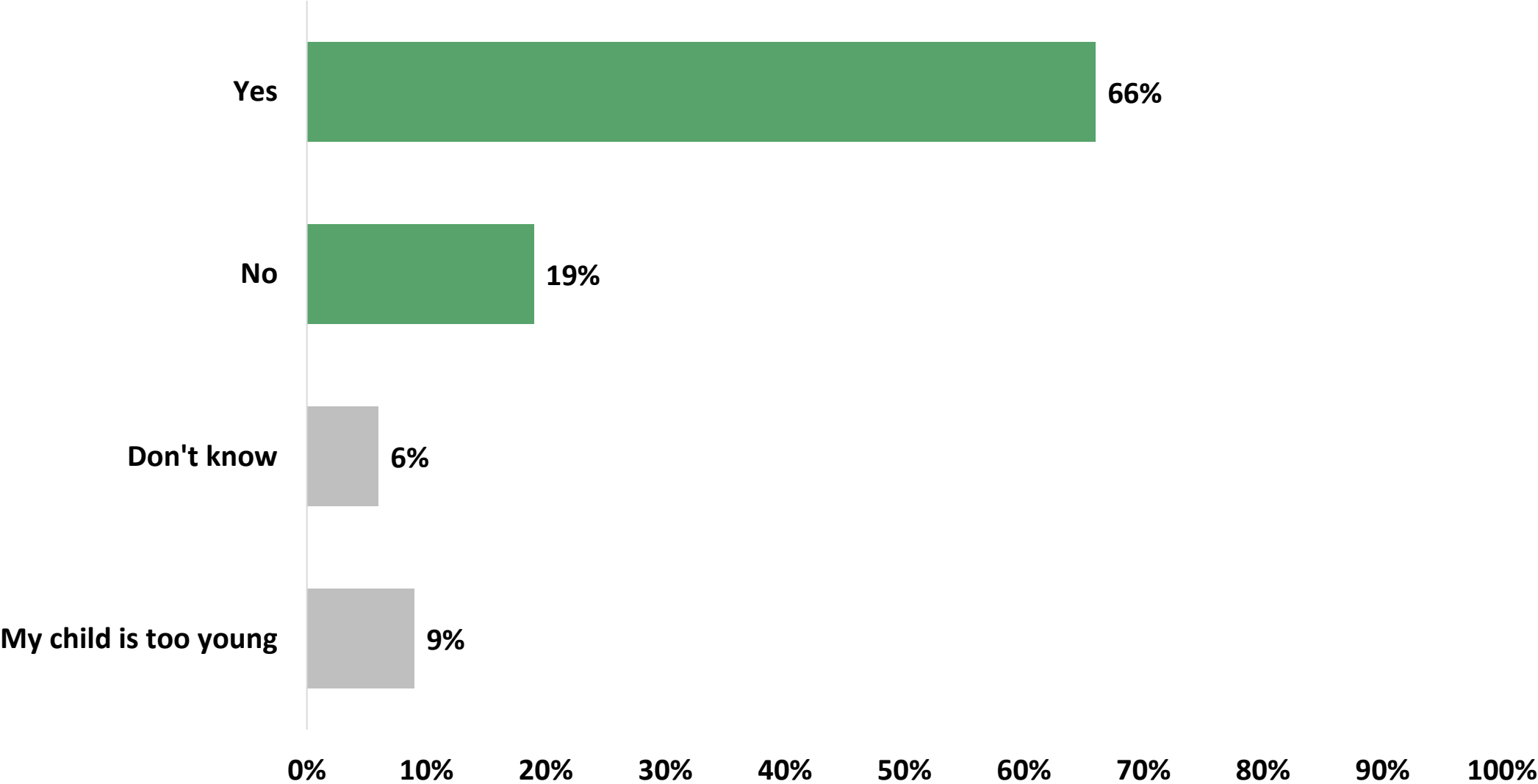

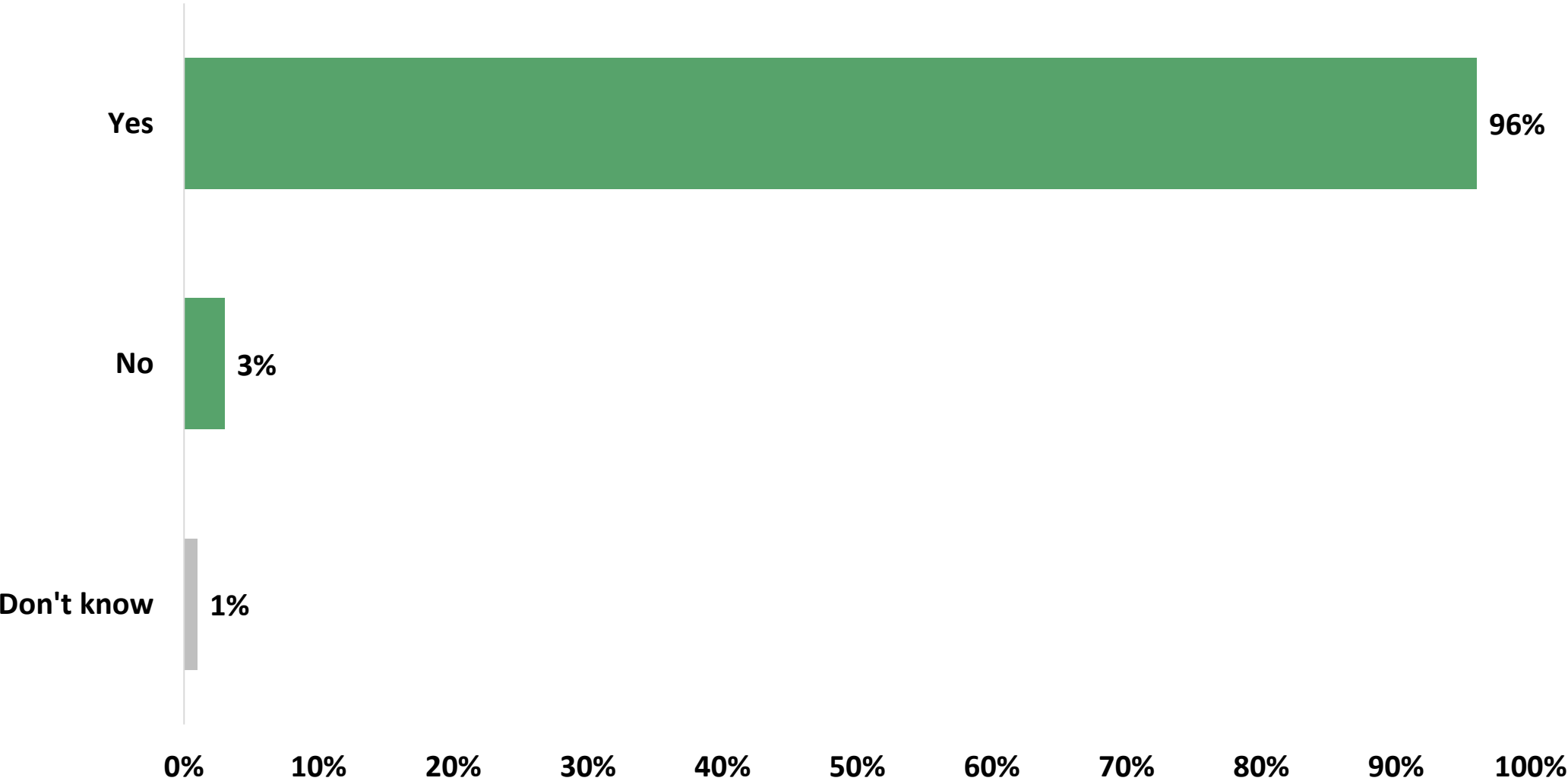
The overall amount of homework my child is asked to complete is:

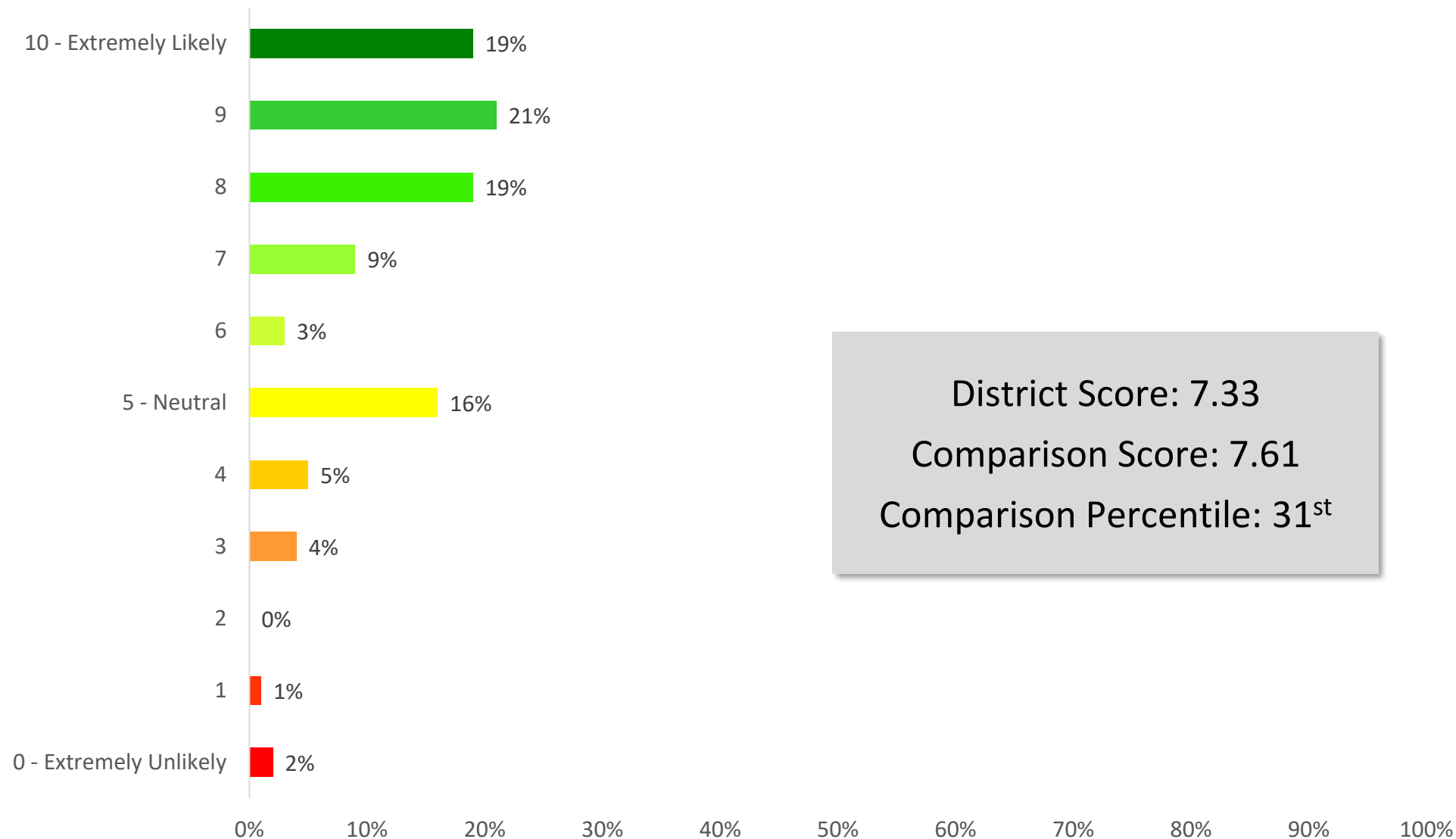
